



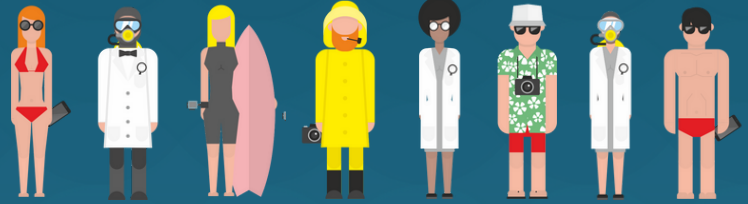

What is RedPROMAR?

The Canary Islands Marine Life Observers Network (RedPROMAR) is a network set up by the Canary Islands Government for the purpose of monitoring and observing marine life in the archipelago through Citizen Science.



How does it operate?

Through the contribution of citizens to a digital resource for recording information related to marine biodiversity, we can predict changes taking place in ecosystems and thus provide proactive responses to environmental pressures.
